## Chapter Rules Revision

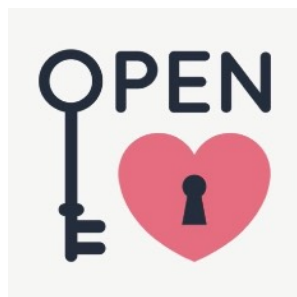


All state and local chapters continue to work on updating their respective governing documents to align them with new international standards that were adopted over the summer.
