## President's Message

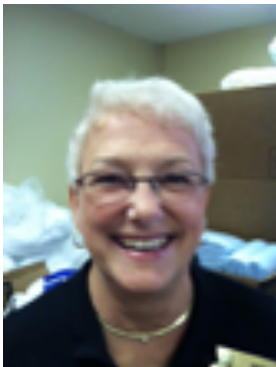
