
Ohio State Organization Convention is Almost Here!!

Convention Attendance Award 2021

Although this year's convention will be virtual, there will still be an award for the chapter(s) with the best attendance.

The five chapters with the highest average percentage of members in attendance at all the convention events, including breakout sessions and meetings, will all be recognized at the fall executive board meeting. The chapter with the highest percentage average overall will have its name engraved on the official State Convention Attendance Award Plaque.

Note: Rankings will be calculated based on the average percentage of all the chapters' members in attendance at each individual session, i.e. members who attend multiple sessions will be included each time they participate in a meeting. The final rankings will be based on cumulative chapter attendance at all convention events and meetings.
