Who knows what good times and challenging times we will have in the upcoming year. But I know as strong women who care about others and our world, we will come through the year stronger and more compassionate.

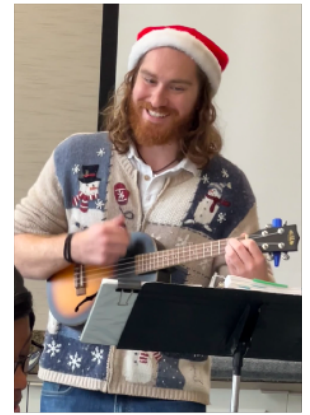
