



What Happens at an International Convention?

The convention agenda is packed with speakers and session, providing a variety of learning opportunities from July 12 - 16 at the Sheraton Hotel in the "Big Easy". International officers are elected and proposed amendments to the DKG Constitution and Standing Rules are considered, debated and voted on. Every member attending the convention has a voice and a vote.

Keynote speaker Courtney Clark will speak on resilience and Ingvi Ómarsson, an acclaimed Icelandic educator and member of the Icelandic ministry of education will bring an international perspective.

Each day includes events, workshops and general sessions for Society business. During these sessions 120 proposed amendments to the DKG governing documents will be brought to the floor. Some of these amendments may impact our chapter.

These amendments include:

- changing the name of the Society
- changing the name of the Nominations Committee to Nominating Committee
- eliminating the induction fee paid by new members
- clarification on collegiate membership
- clarification on membership status
- changes requirement for reserve membership
- creating a new emerita membership classification
- clarification on when dues are paid and the amount paid
- moves collection of the scholarship fee to state organizations
- allowing state organizations to determine the amount and distribution of scholarship fees

Watch this space in the August edition for highlights, photos and the newly adopted amendments that will impact DKG, Ohio and Gamma Phi Chapter.
